

BCTA and USTA Junior Team Tennis

USTA Jr Team Tennis connects kids together in a team format. Matches are played against other teams that are in the same age group and ability level. A match consists of girls and boys singles, girls and boys doubles and mixed doubles. The Brown County Tennis Association supports a local league that is currently coordinated by Kim Wedige.

The main league in Brown County is held during the summer months, ending with a USTA District tournament in early August. Local parks and school tennis courts is where the matches are played. Teams should consist of 6-10 players, minimum of 3 girls and 3 boys. Form your own team or contact Kim and she will help find a team for you to join. Matches are typically played in the afternoon hours during the week.

To Participate a USTA membership is required. There is a fee associated to participate in a league which covers a Nike Dry-Fit league shirt, TennisLink registration, tennis balls, and court/site coordinator fees.

A second league, which is a travel league, takes place in the winter months. Kim works with the local league coordinators from neighboring counties; Kim coordinates the 14's and under division, Pam Hammond (dishmania@aol.com/920-929-9079) coordinates the 18's and under division and Joe Sagen (madbail@northnet.net/920-379-1172) coordinates the 12's and under. Matches are usually played 1 date a month, usually on a Sat evening, and travel to different indoor tennis clubs in those neighboring counties.

Leagues can be formed using the following groupings

12's and under: beginner, intermediate, advanced

14's and under: beginner, intermediate, advanced

18's and under: beginner, intermediate, advanced
